Ziontario Standards of Conduct

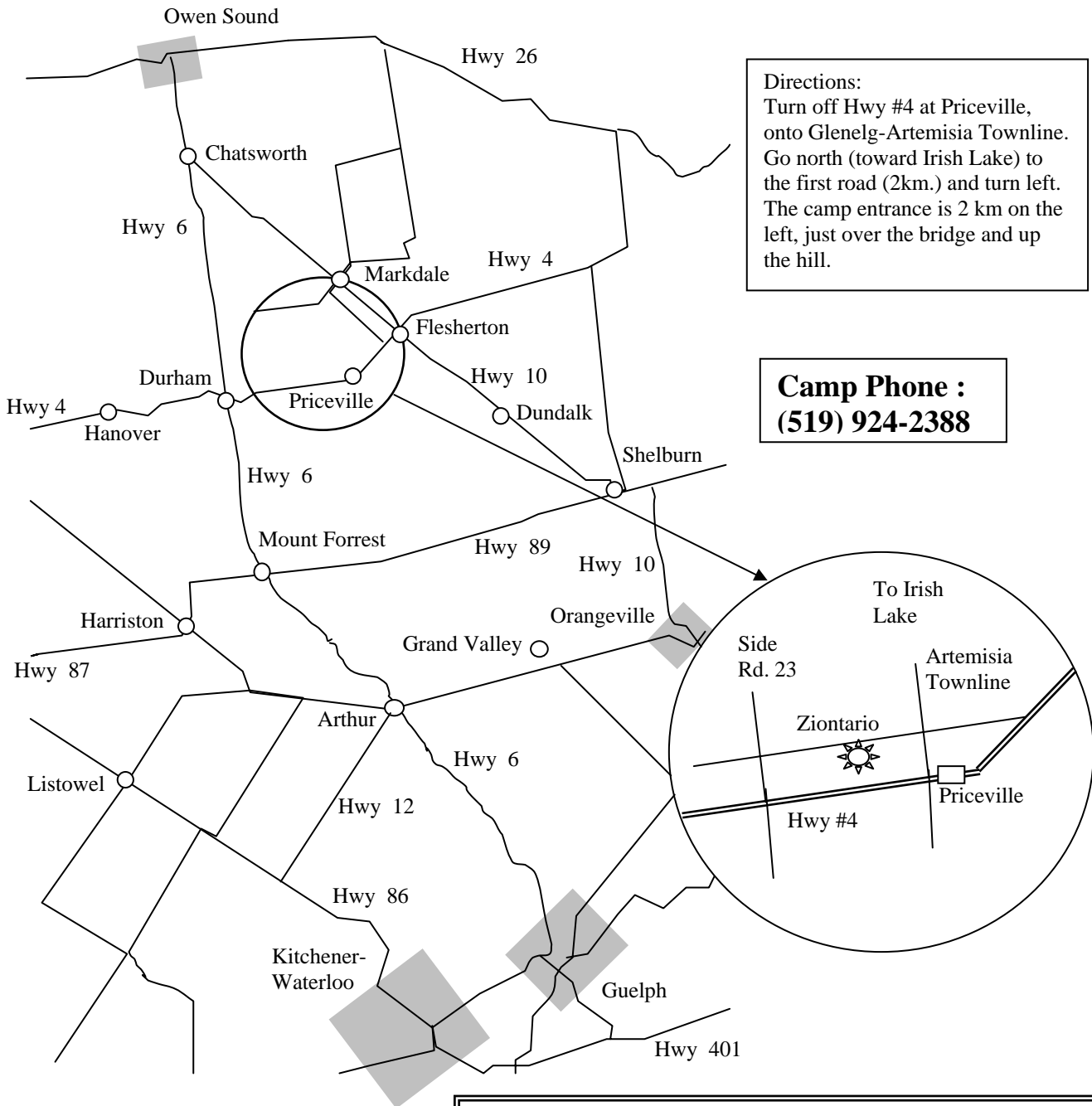
The use of abusive language is discouraged at all times because it distracts from any unity and harmony and degrades a wholesome lifestyle.
